Climbing God's Mountain

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The First Step

Due to there being an “Angel of Darkness” disguised as an “Angel of Light,” people wander around in darkness, considering all to be bright.

“Though I walk through the valley of this shadow of death, I will fear no evil.” What was King David talking about when he wrote this Psalm?

According to the Book of Genesis, we live in a fallen world. I believe we landed in the valley of the shadow of death under Satan’s cloak of darkness, for we are divorced from God through the bloodline of death that we inherited from Adam the first man.

It now only stands to reason that because the devil has the characteristics of a murdering and lying thief, we, being in his kingdom, belong to him and not the kingdom of light and life. Yet, King David is not afraid of any unknown evil because the kingdom of God’s known brilliance of Spirit is upon him.

King David further states, “Your rod and your staff comfort me.” God’s Holy Spirit is there to both correct with guidance and support him with strength in the marrow of his bones as he walks in this world of darkness and not of it.

Earlier in Psalm 23, King David states, “The Lord is my shepherd; there is nothing I lack.” This suggests that he knows stability in an unstable world, for he lacks nothing, and Godliness with contentment is a great gain for him as there is no confusion within his focused mind.

King David is said by God to be a man after God's own heart and "Blessed are the pure in heart for they shall see God." This further suggests that he has a mature relationship with Him from a mountaintop perspective, which he learned by shepherding the sheep in the silence of the wilderness. I have also learned that separating oneself from the distractions of this world is a part of climbing the mountain of God.

David also says in his Psalm, "In green pastures He makes me lie down; to still waters, He leads me; He restores my soul." Green pastures cause me to consider a place of rest as there is provision for him and his people while under the protection of God's authority. This makes King David happy as God's continued blessings act as a perpetual restoration of vision for his soul. For still waters are a reflection of stability to know what manner of man he is.

In the perfect mirror of doing what God requires of him to maintain his peace amongst disrupting spiritual attacks upon the waters, David chooses God over the spirits that make them choppy. He avoids the distortions of vision that could distract God's love from maintaining David's composure through the affection of the Lord's restraints, which makes him a testimony. "He guides me along right paths for His name's sake."

In the midst of all darkness, David said to God, "You set a table before me in front of my enemies. You anoint my head with oil, and my cup overflows." David is fed and sustained from his Lord's kingdom with gladness of joy, "Indeed goodness and mercy will pursue me, all the days of my life; I will dwell in the house of

the Lord for endless days.” I know God causes David to rejoice, for no better place has he found a complete life than walking with the Lord in his kingdom.

We were all dead in our trespasses of sin until Christ has made, will make, and has brought us to full completion in eternal life, granting us freedom to move about by His Holy Spirit.

Now that the chains have been broken from the spirits that had us bound to this world, we are to seek out our spiritual nature in the things beyond this world. We would return to being bound up again otherwise. Like a dog returning to its vomit or a pig to its wallowing in the mud, and again become ensnared by negating our salvation.

2nd Peter chapter. 2: 20-22: “For if they, having escaped the defilement of the world through the knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, again become entangled and overcome by them, their last condition is worse than their first. For it would have been better for them not to have known the way of righteousness than after knowing it to turn back from the Holy Commandment handed down to them.” Jesus also said, “There are those who profess to know Me with their mouths, but their hearts are far from Me.” For there are false teachers who pretend to live in light in the midst of lies and are yet in darkness, promising freedom for all, though they themselves are slaves of corruption. For a person is a slave of whatever overcomes him. Here, swift destruction is granted upon themselves.

People who arrogantly revile the way of the cross do not understand that while in this state of destruction, they will also be

destroyed themselves. For in rejecting the true message of Jesus, being seduced and seducing unstable people themselves, their hearts are trained in greed where the creatures that hide in darkness await them and their followers.

Romans chapters 9, 10, and 11: When we try to establish our own righteousness without being one with God, we negate the fact that God, through His power, is doing the work in us by faith in Jesus Christ. For if we become obsessed with honoring God like the Pharisees and believe that we can do it on our own through the flesh, we cut ourselves off from grace by negating God through a lack of trust and enter unbelief.

The scriptures say that no one who believes that Jesus Christ has risen from the dead for the purpose of salvation will be put to shame. On the other hand, “If God did not spare the natural branches [of Israel], he will not spare you either. See then the kindness and severity towards those who fell, but God’s kindness to you, provided that you remain in His kindness; otherwise, you, too, will be cut off.” There are those who believe they know God but ignore a living and thriving relationship with Him in this world and remain in it, rather than in it and not of it. For if they are grafted into the vine of Christ, they will draw life from His vine and kingdom, not of the world any longer, but at a later time, if anyone recognizes the error of their ways, they will be regrafted to draw life from His vine again as grace remains gracious in that it is grace. For if we experience being touched by God and His Spirit runs dry within us, it is because we turned back again to draw from the vine of fleshly pleasures in the darkness of the world.

The Search

Reality holds many choices that seem to head in either one of two directions, brilliance of light and beyond into purity of love and life having sight, or dim grim death with doldrum spirits with thoughts invasive of mind. Gray is a deception of darkness that drowns and leads all to die without God's grace, lest the Almighty intervene for all to live an eternity with Him.

With foggy sight, men strive to survive while searching for answers to satisfy a soul once and for all. Everyone tries any of everything as poor substitutes for satisfaction but to no avail. "If you'll search for Me with all your heart, you will find me," says the Lord of all.

I searched through kisses and near misses, through jobs with promise until dead ends left me unsatisfied. Through competitions and a triathlon of mazes that left me in dazes, crazed and confused as there was no stability in life, shook me till His first touch of words pricked my heart beyond a surface reality to my core.

It was here I discovered that slowing down caused me friction, and going in this direction seemed differently right. Changes started to happen within me that expanded my sight, for I had something alive in hand that was different and new, a touch of truth that ignited a sparkling light. Then I felt that I had bumped off the green creatures with red eyes and I watched as they slid down the tower walls, for they could not get back into my mind, guarded by God.

My friends turned abusive with me when I no longer went along as par for the course. So, I told them why, and they backed away inside. They now called me crazy, but I was alive. I told them all of what I knew and soon discovered myself alone because I was still shaky and unstable while not completely off my throne. I was using my flesh to state my case and without God's sweet Spirit, I had to learn that my words were bitter to the taste as they were not seasoned with grace.

I had quickly forgotten that God was the judge who had forgiven me of all my wrongs in places where my relationship had been missing Him. It took time, but He was filling me in, slowly teaching me how to love from the darkness of all of my sins as I looked at everyone haughtily on.

I separated myself from the crowd and religiously froze; I felt I had the right to loudly proclaim Him. Yet, it was really spirits that had blinded my mind as I had become compulsively insane, for without God's wisdom, I was alone and could not accept blame.

Faith's First Touch

When we are first born into the Kingdom of God, it takes time for our eyes to adjust. When an infant is first born, its perspective is limited as its eyes are still out of focus. At the same time, its neck muscles are still forming as well as a baby cannot even steady its head. It is like this in the spiritual world as well. We need what is called the milk of the truth of eternal life to help our eyes come into focus on God's kingdom to feed with sight. It takes eternal light through His living and written words to slow us down to observe, as before this, all were disturbed. Remember that "All of creation testifies of God" when we notice that it speaks of Him.

Next, further progress takes place when a baby starts to crawl. Its line of vision gets a little higher, and soon after, it starts exploring its surroundings visually, which motivates it to start to want to walk. Further strengthening its muscles to get to what it sees when it first begins to crawl, it starts to search for answers.

The baby desperately wants what it wants when it wants it, but in God's design, there is a timing that allows the child to develop at a pace to comprehend what it wants before it gets to it. However, there are exceptions to this rule, which gives another spiritual message. For there are those babies that go from crawling to running, and until they slow down to a pause, they'll not ponder things beyond distraction or know how to perceive what they want at the appropriate times to get their needs met. It is necessary for all to learn to slow down to a pause without missing any stepping stones, for when missing steps, learning discomfort will be

experienced. Without starting out on a firm foundation of reality, steps shall need to be re-traced before any focus becomes better. Then, greater clarity comes by sizing up situations by identifying what was missing for healthier choices. Steps that were previously needed to comprehend present conditions have come into sight on a higher level for a more complete life.

The Stepping Stone

Finding out that this world leaves one dissatisfied is a big step. It leads to a search for the deeper truth of why things are the way they are and a quest for answers to the riddle beyond mere existence on this round sphere called Earth.

For a season, we may pass the time, not considering this quest for many years. Although, etching out a niche to make ourselves feel comfortable while here, we take this as the norm because we have not been introduced to it in any other way. Throughout life, it is easy to move along with everybody else's learned behavior when presuming that this world is all there is. When no steps are taken to find another way, we go with the flow.

Yet, what is life, and why is it? These are other questions that lead to steps to find a door to start a climb on God's mountain. Jesus, at the summit of God's mountain, came down to earth to lift everybody to see and join His mountain of the kingdom of light. For eternal life is a life of stability with God's perspective. Finding the foundation of Jesus Christ to build us up leads to a building of line upon line, precept upon precept, here and there, a little out of all that is dark. Jesus is the chief and cornerstone of our faith, from which all other steps follow. This is not easy to comprehend, but He is the guiding step for all to grow up from darkness and gain height for a perspective with sight. Then, as reality comes into greater focus, understanding comes.

In addition to being the chief and cornerstone of our faith, Jesus is also the first seed for all to grow and have sight to be

guided by the Holy Spirit of light to become a part of God's mountain. For just as a plant starts out beneath the soil in darkness, so do we grow, too.

Out of the kingdom of darkness, once breaking free, we enter into the kingdom of light as we grow from being rooted and grounded in love out of the depths of soil and into eternal life.

The Seed

Jesus said, “Unless a grain of wheat dies and falls into the ground, it cannot reproduce after its own kind.” When a good seed is planted on well-prepared soil in a living soul, we die to the flesh and start to grow. Coming alive in the Holy Spirit, He carries the grain of God’s acquiescent substance to us.

The seed of grain comes to us in various ways during our different stages of spiritual growth. Thus far, we have had faith to believe that everything around us appears to be true by someone else’s dark estimations. Or, perhaps the spirits speaking through the thoughts of the minds of these others who only have an appearance of being genuine with us but really are disingenuous. Pretenders are not authentic. For they listen to the voices of others and become parrots in their parody of life.

The devil would prefer we never have an identity of our own by finding out what God made us to originally be by the Holy Spirit’s voice of truth. When someone has been trained to believe that a lie is the truth long enough, it makes it harder to have faith in any other concept or person at all, God included.

A well-prepared soil focuses a soul on the light of God’s kingdom of light in place of its own dim darkness. Within the warmth of God's Spirit of truth and love in balance, we discover that God has a pure and living bloodline that brings the fire of life to a soul.

Faith comes by hearing and hearing by the word of an eternal God. When we stop believing in what the spirit of man says over

God's voice, it becomes the substance of the meat of the word, replacing its milk. The Holy Spirit removes and prevents us from having a divided mind to find a single focus on God's completion of reality from the summit of all - Jesus Christ.

When studying to show myself approved, I originally fed on the milk of the word through the Holy Spirit alone. I later discovered that this was only a stepping stone to lay a foundation to receive the meat of the word, the Holy Eucharistic meal of thanksgiving. It took time, but God revealed to me that Jesus is also the Holy Host Himself as I've been led by the Holy Spirit, who is the leader and guide into all truth to receive Him.

We find eternal life in more than just what is within the life of the Holy Spirit originally brought to us. "The Church" is God's bride that needs to be met from beyond this world as we are now a part of God's kingdom, for we have become born again and birthed into it. It is also for this reason that we need to be fed and provided for while we are within it, for according to the scriptures, we are in this world and no longer of it. We are fed by God in keeping with His new covenant, after being clothed in the garment of His Spirit of truth, for Jesus was clothed in glory on the mountain of transfiguration as the second Adam for us to follow.

Welcome to the marriage supper of the "Lambs Table," where the altar of sacrifice awaits you. For as the bridegroom says, "Come!" Jesus bids to us through a consecrated priest as His prepared church bride filled with the essence of Himself by His true word of the Holy Spirit. A union has been made in Holy

matrimony by another line of resurrection growth for all who partake in a worthy manner of understanding.

The seed has been planted on good soil, and now a union between us and God will allow us to see within God's kingdom when walking in the light. We have received more of an understanding of eternal life in the Spirit.

A Seed of Light

John 3:3: “Amen, amen, I say to you, no one can see the kingdom of God unless he was born from the kingdom above.” During a storm, when warm and cool air come together, there is a rapid succession of friction turned to heat, which sparks the fire of a lightning brilliance of heavenly light on one side of a whirlwind, but on the other, cool air becomes cold freezing rain, which turns to hail that can freeze to burn at the same time.

Jesus was able to rebuke the winds and cause them to be stilled to a calm during a violent storm at sea. He knew how to command the wind when confronting the storm with the wisdom of His knowledge of the spiritual world. I see God overruling Satan during this battle on the sea of Galilee as He spoke the truth of the Holy Spirit and overruled the world's spirits with His authority. He made the statement of “Light Be” through His power of creation of action and word coming together, which created an opposing force that disbanded the storm. In this statement, I hear His voice saying, “See My light and be set free from all darkness.”

The devil whispers to us through his minion spirits upon the wind that is lesser than God’s Holy Spirit: “Greater is He that is in me than he that is in the world.” There is also a battle within the mind. Lightning-fast electrical impulses within the brain create clarity for a more focused picture of reality. This happens in the midst of where once there was darkness from a lack of knowledge till it adds up to the light of wisdom to equip us.

“Walk in the light while you have the light, lest darkness overtake you,” God speaks the substance of truth into being for creation purposes from a foundation of living blood, which generates the warmth of pure love. In turn, this creates a friction that goes against everything that is not of love. A growth cycle is formed here: It contains friction that generates heat, sparking a fire that turns to light from a base of love that states, “Light be!” This happens in each circular building block of growth in creation, keeping everything in balance. “For lest the Lord build the house, they that labor will labor in vain.”

God has an established pattern, as everything is built on building blocks that promote life. “If you lose your life for my name's sake, you will find it.” Reject this world of darkness, and you will be translated from being out of the kingdom of darkness and into the kingdom of light.

A centurion approached Jesus and asked He to heal his servant, who was like a son. I believe he could discern that Jesus was from the kingdom of an unseen world with the light of an answer. When he was before Him, he humbled himself in acknowledgment of it.

“When Jesus entered Capernaum, a centurion approached him and pleaded for help. Matthew 8 6-13: “Lord,” he said, “my servant is lying at home paralyzed and enduring agonizing sufferings.” Jesus said to him, “I will come and cure him.” The centurion replied, “Lord, I am not worthy to have you come under my roof. But simply say the word, and my servant will be healed. For I myself am a man subject to authority, with soldiers who are

subject to me. I say to one, 'Go,' and he goes, and to another, 'Come here,' and he comes, and to my servant, 'Do this,' and he does it."

When Jesus heard this, he was amazed and said to those following him, "Amen, I say to you, in no one throughout Israel have I found faith as great as this. Many, I tell you, will come from the east and the west to sit with Abraham and Isaac and Jacob at the banquet in the kingdom of heaven. But the kingdom's heirs will be thrown into the outer darkness, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth."

Jesus then said to the centurion, "Return home. Your petition has been granted because of your faith." And at that very hour, the servant was healed.

It is always important to remember that when making our requests known before God, "He who exalts himself will be humbled just as he who humbles himself will be exalted." For at another time, Jesus walked the earth as our example of resurrection life. He said, "Whoever loves his life loses it, and whoever hates his life in this world will preserve it for eternal life. Whoever serves me must follow me, and where I am, my servant must also be. The father who serves me will honor me." After saying this, I believe that Jesus experienced being God as man, for He next states, "I am troubled now'. Yet what shall I say? 'Father, save me from this hour? But it was for this purpose that I came to this hour. Father, glorify your name.' Then a voice came from heaven, 'I have glorified it and will glorify it again.'"

I have noticed in my life that after hearing from God, the devil tries to diminish His voice to sow doubt as to what God requires of me. All must watch for this in their lives, or they will be ineffective in God's kingdom. Even worse, as is written in the Book of Hebrews, as our example, the children could not enter the Land of Promise due to their unbelief. Pay careful attention to this next passage and see if you notice anything in the spiritual realm: "I'd rather that you were hot or cold, for the lukewarm I will spew out of my mouth." Also, remember that scripture to help you focus.

"The crowd there heard the voice of God and said, 'It was thunder.' Others said, 'An angel had spoken unto him.'"

Do you notice any diminishing spirits that might be at work here?

Jesus answered, saying, "This voice did not come for my sake but for yours. Now is the time of judgment on this world; now, the ruler of this world will be driven out."

If the ruler of this world has already been cast out, are we not seated in heavenly places in the spirit within eternal life now? When we walk in the spirit, we do not fulfill the lust of the flesh, and we are not already in an eternal life kingdom. As an eternal life citizen in heaven, I am absent from the body and present with the Lord. Just like where two are in the field, and one is in this world and not of this world while the other one is still in this world and of this world. "Blessed are those who hunger and thirst after righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven."

“Godliness with contentment is great gain” because I am content in my joy in the kingdom of eternal life.

Starting the Climb

Having been grafted into the root of God's mountain, I, as a branch, have started my climb while joining His vine one day at a time, for "We are to redeem the time for the days are evil." I notice a change within me as I arrive. Yet my focus is still dim, and I question the truth of my new situation and what has just happened. My ascension up God's mountain in a relationship begins to break the barriers of time. I realize now that my old roots, attaching me to the world of trusting in my own abilities, have been severed. I have left the darkness of the soil found in the realm of time, though lying spirits tell me otherwise, calling to me with whispers upon my mind.

It is a fight not to doubt the promises of God when everything around me seems the same, but then I look in the mirror within my eyes, and I see that I am changed. Then I step away and forget what He looks like, the Spirit of the living God I have invited to take up residence inside while I slowly grow.

Higher up now, my perspective of the world has started to change as people look different to me, for I can start to tell who in my life is genuinely real or living a lie.

Wait a minute. Is God speaking to me now by impressing thoughts by His Spirit upon my mind? Or is it the voice of enticement of my flesh, a devil, or perhaps it is an allure from the world? I'm experiencing friction by pausing to feel my core and knowing that all is becoming unraveled from my life in my being still to know that God is God. Further growth from within and up

the side of the mountain brings heat, and I am made to feel further discomfort through a recurring dream of floating in large cities, which appear as tombstones.

I am then given a choice from my many discomforts of turning back or continuing through these fiery trials that try to ensnare me to remain in the confusion of the dark. After the fire, I burned till there was only brilliance, as it is known: "To know God is to know eternal life." In brilliance, there is light, for "Jesus Christ is the light and life of all men." In each growth stage of eternal life, there's a resurrection by the light and living blood of Jesus Christ.

This is where I learned that Almighty God had changed something within the essence of my being, for when remaining on His path, what hides in darkness yields to light. He has changed me by going to Him and asking many requests. Being changed within the personhood of the catalyst of the Holy Spirit and through Christ's resurrection blood, I know that God is refashioning me, for I did not create myself from the beginning.

I also want to state that building and coming to understand God's boundaries of love both build a relationship with Him and place the protection of His armor on you. You will know that He is putting His armor on you when you feel changes occurring in you according to His healthy pattern of love that you didn't do, for here, you cannot help but acknowledge the truth of His existence. God exists beyond and behind all of truth, holding everything together. So just as a knight has a page, placing his armor upon him, God's angels of love will place His armor on you to comprehend healthy boundaries of Love. "Love never fails.

Discovering Deeper Prayer

When you realize that God is a God of like passions with purity, unlike us, as He is without sin, this gives us a sight of comparison. You can acknowledge He has the patience to endure long-suffering for all of our asked and unasked requests. This is what Jesus Christ experienced on the cross for all mankind.

A bittersweet flavor of sorrow and gratitude keeps things in perspective for me. My sorrow is that I know that my inherited sins from Adam put Him there, and my gratitude is for Him loving me enough to shed his bloodline of life to be with the Lord forever. This joy gives me strength in the wellspring of my soul. He has planted me on His firm foundation, which allows me to grow without falling down to start over again. So, as long as I remain mindful, it is by His mercy and grace that I can taste the full goodness of His flavor. I now keep my balance with Him, holding me while I am in this unstable world. This is how I have been growing into eternal life from out of time.

On stable ground, I am able to speak with Him from within His kingdom. This Holy ground is where I am able to bond in a conversation where messenger angels take words from my mouth to Him and get His response as they are sent back down.

The warmth of this bond, when experienced long enough, brings His love to ignite our souls with light for sight. We can now see to call upon the Lord to remove the darkness of confused

choices in our lives. He replaced these spaces of our dark places to fill the chambers where we were missing Him by sin.

Prayer allows us to press in and cling more fervently as our roots go deeper into eternity. This causes us to sprout upward in the Lord's vine till more of God is experienced in the eternal life of His Spirit, more than down here on earth, "To be absent from the body is to be present with the Lord." As "We are rooted and grounded in the love of God," knowledge of Holy grace moves us further up the mountain, which extends beyond time.

Plateau's Bring Discernment

Through prayer, I drew from the vine's root as a branch grafted into the kingdom of light by the truth of the seed through the second Adam - Jesus Christ.

He entered the world through Mary's womb with living eternal blood, commingled with the Creator to teach us the light of love, which originally brought all creation into being. In each stage of my growth, I grew out from the dimness of darkness because my focus gradually came to know the brilliance of light.

Every time more light comes into my life, I have grown in a complete stage to move onto the next transformative level of my growth in my relationship with the living God. I have been growing spiritually, much like a plant, which started when I paused to come out from the motion of the whirlwinds to find the answer to the riddle of life.

In each growth stage, I have learned a complete lesson that has allowed me to go on to the next level of understanding. You cannot plant a seed in a hurricane, for how can one truly embrace anything unless they are truly stable within themselves? There is no true perspective without peace. Learning something compulsively drives one from peace; this is a dark light that does not allow one to embrace God to grow in a relationship with Him. This nugget of truth has gone deeper than anything I have known. I must embrace the life it is giving me and the stability it brings, as this cornerstone is something that I can build upon. The knowledge of each plateau, which causes me to gain more sight on God's mountain, I compare to a plant's stages of growth, as it allows me to see others in their progressions from my new perspective. This I call discernment, for I know that if I go back, I will be throwing the value of the start of my thriving life off the edge of a cliff, which would destroy me.

The freshness of what I am tasting has me on a good path, and although I am enjoying the view, I am hungry for more of who I am encountering; it is time to move on.

We Are What We Eat

I have tried the flavor of man's knowledge from many books I have read, but after a time, I realized that it only locked my mind into the reality of being dim. We are incomplete and have limitations, so how can we grow very tall when our mountains of wisdom are so small? The view I've received in building relationships with those around me had only one plateau after my climb. Then, my view soon became stale as if in jail, for when the love of common bonds goes missing, all grows pale.

God's mountain is different, though, as you never reach the top while in the realm of time. So, your discovery remains sweet; it is consistently fresh no matter how high you climb. Growing with understanding makes us sane. There is no confusion from the dark, for nuggets of truth contain only light. This kind of advancement produces joy inside a soul, and reaching many plateaus allows us to discern that we have eternally grown.

I continue to grow while drawing strength from the vine's root, and this is where I come to see that when I meet with God in covenant each time, my view becomes clearer line upon line. Love is the mortar to lay each brick of truth, and because the plum line of Israel is true, the messiah, Jesus Christ, builds us on the firm foundation of the God who keeps His promise. We will not fall down on the unstable foundation of the sands of time because God's bloodline does not lie or die. Eternal life is a permanent dwelling of true light and life. For what is stable remains when the

lying spirits come riding upon the winds to invade a soul as they have no place to enter.

“Everything that can be shaken will be shaken so that which will remain will remain.” Jesus Christ is a sure stone, a tried and tested stone who endured all on the cross so that the incomplete would be overcome by completion, which is His finished work.

This is why we have an established covenant that has cracked open time. I know this to be true because I have been caught up to heaven within the vine of Christ beyond all seconds in only a moment. From out of their living, regenerative blood came their love, igniting light into the life of all creation as a part of it and yet separate simultaneously at the same time.

We are what we eat, and I have been feeding on God’s Spirit first as a stepping stone in my growth. Then, passing through the door of friction, heat, burning fire, and light in each compartment of God opening and closing, He led me by the Holy Spirit through the last and yet first door to His throne. They are all open to grant me entrance to the trust of His heart, but not by my strength, as it is a throne of mercy and grace.

I serve a victorious God who now weeps over the fact that His children are abusing themselves and each other in their pride. “For they have not because they ask not.” For when they ask, they ask with wrong motives, looking to please the desires of the flesh without considering God’s better choices of love for them.

How do you bridge the gap between Christianity and other world religions? How does one love through the destruction of division as hate divides and breaks the unity of God’s children? What will end this division that breaks God’s heart to see his children fighting and killing each other? There will be no peace until abuse is replaced by love.

I had a vision that I received from our creator and living God. This vision came from a direct experience that I had with God. I was given a Holy Spirit invitation that caught me up to experience the purity of God’s great love, which was a refreshing drink. It was a foretaste to not only encourage me of the things to

come but deliver a message to all mankind: There is a light of understanding that comes from love loving love in the bond of creation of all life, which explodes outward from a living heritage of God's regenerative bloodline.

The Lord is coming to collect only love and not abuse by drawing it back unto Himself in the centrality of everything that encourages life. Those who abuse and do not love will not be gathered back to the core of God unless they find and come to Him out of all that is dark to His kingdom of light through His door.

“Do everything as unto the Lord.” It is easy to love one another when we know our Creator loves us all the same. We all have a heritage that God has originally ordained for us. Unfortunately, we now have to grow into it as we continue building our relationship with Him. It is an arduous undertaking, but God values His children enough to one day be in love with Him through being regenerated by the recalibrating blood of His Son. John 17 22 and 26: “And I have given them the glory that you gave me, so that they may be one as we are one.” and “I made known to them your name and will make it known that the love in which you loved me will be in them and I in them.” God wants to restore His living bloodline to everyone; those who choose His light and life to replace darkness and death will receive resurrection as an inheritance. I believe this is why we partake of the Holy Eucharist on earth as it is in heaven at every mass. In the taking of the completion of God's thanksgiving meal in heaven, we continue to grow to enter into full union with God in the power of His

resurrection transformation, 1 Corinthians 9-12: “For we know partially and we prophesy partially when the perfect (union of love) comes, the partial shall pass away.
