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What is Faith?

Thoughts

Where do our thoughts come from in which we make our choices? When guesstimating where choices are from, our thoughts are without the light of God to see the root from which we draw. "We are to take every thought captive under the subjection of Jesus Christ." I believe that thoughts have spiritual roots, which either draw from Satan's kingdom or God's, yielding to a power of creation towards life or death.

By following God's voice to examine our thoughts in the above scripture, we are called to understand what the character of Jesus looks like. Are we bearing the fruits of the Holy Spirit? This question should make us effective gardeners within our mind. If a thought tries to grow or has been growing in our minds that does not look like Jesus, it must be pulled out. James goes on to say, "Rather, each person is tempted when he is lured and enticed by his own desire," from his impulsive thoughts that lacked understanding. "Then desire conceives and brings forth sin, and when sin reaches maturity it brings forth death," where there is more room for spirits to hide in the dark, come, and devour to pull us apart. When the mind is made dim here, our lives become unmanageable to see what we choose to make choices in life.

We have been born in sin and where we are missing God's presence, darkness has our minds in the absence of Him. Our thoughts originally had only the Holy Spirit as light, but now we belong to Satan, until God through His Son, makes all things right. "If any man says that he is without sin then the love of the Father is not in Him."

You cannot have discernment without proper vision, for when all is dark in the distortion of feelings, you'll trip and fall every time. However, once thoughts and emotions are cohesive, our detachment from them disappears for the balance of maximum perceptiveness.

Then we can properly examine our situations with clarity and not spiritual confusion. It is important to know what Jesus does and doesn't look like according to the character of the fruits of the Holy Spirit, or we can be drawn away.

"Be still and know that I am God." It is evident that we need to know each moment for perspective. For just as, "A kingdom divided against itself cannot stand," what is still cannot connect with the compulsion of motion. Peace differs from commotion in that, "If you sow to the wind you will reap a whirlwind," but if, "Seated in heavenly places with Christ Jesus," you'll find, "Godliness with contentment is great gain," For, "You will reap what you sow." Scattered knowledge has no clarity whereas Godly wisdom has light.

There is no guesstimating with the mind of Christ as you can see with wisdom in His kingdom and know how to apply knowledge with light. There is a meal that goes forth when sharing life, for the flavor is sweet as it feeds the soul while others feed along with you. As just as, "A laborer is worthy of His hire," it is also known, "Do not muzzle the ox in the field while He is working."

Cause & Effect

For every action there is an equal and opposite reaction.

In physics, when you exert force against an object or mass, it sets it in motion because it overcomes its being still from its set position, called inertia.

The fact that you need to apply a maximum force or (thrust energy) to dislodge a mass out of stability to make it unstable by placing it in motion, explains the break in reality between God and what happened to the original man.

The spiritual world is different from the physical world and yet together at the same time as this keeps all things in balance. In the foundation of God's world, every spiritual act affects the physical world. This was the case when Adam made his spiritually-deciding thought to physically dislodge himself through his doorway of disobedience which landed us all in the death sentence of this world. For once set in motion by his disobedient act, his subjective self was objectively set in motion due to his actions. Now with less force, we're all kept in motion and this needs to be rectified.

He breaks the demonic powers that feed our thoughts to be in our minds to expend our energy by acting out physically. God uses His light to make a way for us to call upon Him. He reveals to us what to ask of Him when we are stressed.

Guesstimating causes us to divide our minds into a confusingly dry and stale life of boredom, which happens when practicing what we don't understand, and this allows an off balanced motion to keep settling in. While a life of serving God keeps it fresh and alive, for within a life of singularity, a single mind has a reverse resistance to motion. Therefore no energy is being spent. This allows for a calm foundation of peace, outside of motion, where everything can be built on a lasting eternal last that will never fail as it won't come tumbling down. "For everything that can be shaken will be shaken so that which shall remain will remain." I understand that the realm of time lacks stability as its foundation is not sound. So, by looking on with sight in what's understood, this is how I discern what kingdom I am in that of time or eternity.

I have observed that the faster one's mind races within their thoughts, the more anxious they get. Could the scripture, "The dead in Christ shall rise again," also mean that when you still the mind and come out of motion to enter peace, a change in your perspective takes place where you leave time and enter eternity? I have learned that God slows us down to teach us more when answering the call to climb His Mountain. I am not sure where I am on it, but from the height He has taken me, I am sharing what He has revealed from the view that He has shown me.

Prayer is a reverse thrust of energy that goes against motion and slows us down out of dark commotion to go into an orbit around God till landing in the heart of His love. For without the confusion of darkness, as we gain perspective from each plateau, there is the Holy Spirit's guiding Light that allows us to connect with God's embrace. Beyond any deception that has harmed, we're healed in the sanctuary of His arms as "God's love restrains us," and never fails.

During this process, we pray through friction, heat, and burning flames of fire until there is only light. Going against unseen spiritual forces that ride on the winds, we battle against them. These minions try to deceive us into turning back by making prayer progressively uncomfortable through pumping adverse thoughts within our minds that are contrary to the voice of God. Although once through them and into the light, the minions are pushed back by the true light of stillness found in Jesus Christ.

It is a fight to go against the unnatural properties of this world which seem natural to us. Just as a weed might seem natural to a flower until it realizes that its roots are being strangled as its colors start to fade to its demise. In spite of David's arrogant pride and hardened heart, Nathan the prophet was sent to him to settle with God and make all things right due to his multiple sins, including the sin of murder. In stage one of establishing our spiritual boundaries, we are in a darkness in which our minds are dim till the warmth of love starts to ignite our souls to see with light within. For after being overrun by others, I caved inside while in the dark of an abyss within the depths of where demons ruled, residing in the trough of the wave of time. Then while passing through the seconds of its meandering length, I felt like a river run dry. In contrast, I also strived to reach its heights, but encountered an angel of darkness disguised as an angel of light. For success in this world leaves you in this world and not of the kingdom where one reaches God to truly connect with Him. "This people honor me with their mouths but their hearts are far from me." The difference in the way these scriptures were spoken during this discussion is that one honored God in humility as Jesus knew that He had nothing to prove. For He spoke from a foundation of peace with stability while using the voice of life. The other voice was a challenger with a commotion to throw Jesus from His Kingdom of eternal peace by trying to bait Him into the motion of pride. One spoke the word and one was the word, which Jesus spoke as a part of Himself while being in this world and not of it.

John 17:20, 21: "I pray not only for them, but also for those who will believe in me through their word. So that they may all be one, as we are one." We are spiritually alive in eternal life now and later get our heavenly tents physically unless we choose to believe Satan's lies, which will make us ineffectually lukewarm. For grace is the doorway to holiness, it is not grease where you just slide by. "I would rather you be hot or cold, for the lukewarm I will spew out of my mouth," says God.

In the second stage of growth, we recognize that we were being overrun by abusive people without any love. For when one is not protected by God, a feeding frenzy takes place in lives that are thrashing to stay alive. This is where everything is confusing and we strive to stay alive while the love of God goes missing within, which is sin.

Growing in the third stage, we recognize that it's not about other people but the spirits that are living within them that are dulling their minds towards abuse. For their perception of love and truth joining together is still an off-balanced mess while trying to get out of the hole they are digging by themselves. Seeing things darkly in the lukewarmness of their faith, they need to be prayed for as love never fails to edify. So, "We are to be quick to listen, slow to speak, and not to enter into strife." For after feeding on God's word as milk

and steak, maturity allows us to see when we're being baited by spiritual forces to lose God's peace through the strength of our own power.

If we keep resting in the Lord and develop all His Spiritual fruits, we'll reach a place where against these, there is no law as we have taken root. Galatians 5:18 "But if you are guided by the spirit, (love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control), you are no longer under the law." So beware of being compulsive and unnatural by not being true to who you are. For when you are content within, you will find yourself comfortable in your own skin. Sharing God's love comes naturally here when standing firm on Christ. He is the essential foundation of God's peace where others can enter into a relationship with the you in Jesus, then experience the inside joy of rest.

Remember, when it comes to boundaries, Satan is always rude as this fallen angel's minions pound your mind with thoughts to gain access to divide your soul. For once your soul is breached, the single-minded focus of the Holy Spirit will be broken from within. You'll recognize an attack once your toe has been stepped on as you'll become restless within.

"Seek peace and pursue it." Call out to God and refocus on Him or a foothold will gain entrance to entice you into a stronghold of sin where if you lose humility, it will be hard to get back to Him. This is also made evident by losing your peace when taking matters into your own hands. For when the flesh rises up, things get chaotic, and speaking in anger can lead you to rage. Is anything really worth losing your eternal peace over? For while this happens, you enter into Satan's domain for minions to feed off your energy. You'll know you're in the wrong kingdom when you hear yourself complain.

Backbiting is a sign that you're praying to what lies in darkness rather than the kingdom found in eternal life. Therefore, after you've gotten your point across, if you continue standing your ground peacefully in God's Kingdom of rest, you have not entered Satan's domain. Mark my words, a battle is lost every time that you feel depleted inside as a minion has had a meal. This is how you can tell that a spiritual boundary has been broken from a guesstimate.

Trust

What holds your vision? Is it real in the way that you want to achieve a result?

Before riding a horse, it's a good idea to have its owner introduce it to you, then feed and make friends with it first. For if you try to immediately exert force over it in pride, within a no love kind of spirit, chances are that you will get thrown from the saddle of life. However, while you're learning guidance from the Holy Spirit of truth, grace allows you to get back in the saddle again till you learn to be carried by Jesus in eternal life. I live one day at a time while learning to recognize my source of life.

Knowing the one who owns your life is essential. For although a wild horse may seem like a challenge at first, it will wear you down as you get older and you will find yourself ill-equipped to find its owner to teach you mastery later on.

In learning to know myself, I remained a mystery until I learned God's history, which left me in awe. For I had found the basic instructions before leaving earth, The Bible, to have a plan. Then after reading it and studying it for so many years, I asked the question, "Where did it come from?" Why, there was a history behind this book that caused me to take a second look. For some of my interpretations had been off. Without understanding its foundation, I had no real reference point from which to draw.

An experienced seaman knows have to navigate the ocean by using the stars. I had to learn to navigate through the Bible by learning it had a New Covenant reference point from which to draw. Now my course was guided from the history of the church, which explained The New Covenant as a solid cross reference for me to

navigate by. I now have a plan to follow that replaces my guesstimating.

"Seek ye first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, then all these things will be added unto you." You know in your heart of hearts if you're being insincere with God or not. For if you guess that everything is alright with Him in unknown factors, it is really not.

Speaking from experience, when you do not really serve Him completely by trusting Him enough to lay down your life, "You reap what you sow." You will not reap a full eternal spiritual life, or perhaps, as I mentioned earlier in the scriptures, "The lukewarm, I will spew out of my mouth." So, if you've been traveling through life by navigating in the confusion of a dark and spiritual pride, now is the time to tame the horse by humbly giving it to God. 2nd Peter 3:11-16 "Since everything is supposed to be concluded in this way, what sort of persons ought you to be, conducting yourselves in holy devotion, waiting for and hastening the day of God; because of which the heavens will be dissolved in flames and the elements melted by fire. But according to His promise we await new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells. Therefore beloved since you await these things, be eager to be found without spot or blemish before Him, at peace. And consider the patience of our Lord of salvation as our beloved brother Paul, according to the wisdom given to Him, also wrote to you, speaking of these things as he does in all his letters. Some things are hard to understand that the ignorant and unstable distort to their own destruction, just as they do the other scriptures."

So, remain teachable and trust that God will send you the right instructors who bear the Holy Spirit's fruit from Him at the right time. They will be guided with roots of love and grounded in peace and joy. Remember, unstable people guesstimate and have no firm

foundation of truth within themselves. These false teachers will only cause you to stumble in the end. For the foundation that they build on is as unstable as the sands of time. Yet, the plumb line of Christ has a foundation that remains ever steadfast and true for you to build out of time and into eternity, too. The one who teaches falsely, their ground shall not be at peace, for the unstable guesses within themselves. Do not build with them as a relationship with God shall bow and fall down as an unstable wall in the end. "For when the blind lead the blind the two fall into a ditch," which is a fallen earth in the valley of the shadow of death.

Time

"Man plans and God Laughs." Everyone wants to do things according to their timetable. Yet most do not realize that all time spent in freedom belongs to God.

God's timing is a time of rest, "Be still and know that I am God." In His still presence, there's an inner peace with Him as we are in His kingdom of light, which has a comprehension of what He reveals to us in our sight. A light is seen, not to run from when appearing off in the distance, but to grow towards. In all other avenues of life, when walking without having peace, there are disturbances from the kingdom of confusion, and it is hard to see throughout the darkness of this night.

Whether we are being distracted, deflected, or deceived away from being present with God, losing focus on the timing of His kingdom, we find ourselves sinking in the troubles of our world. Like Peter, who got distracted from looking at Jesus while walking on the waters of the Sea of Galilee. He started to sink when he looked at the waves of His surroundings, then fearing to drown in the murk of all around; Peter cried out, "Save me!"

Jesus was there in an instant. Soon after, they were found safely within the boat, a place of sanctuary from the storm. Stillness in the commotion of the wave of time in which this fallen world is caught within the breadth, passing through all of its seconds, Jesus is our anchor.

When questioning time, I slowed through its realm of darkness and burned through friction, heat, and fire till gaining entrance beyond the door and into the kingdom of light. This is where I met Jesus in His love, and by His divine mercy, I am cleansed daily through His Spirit within a commingling of His blood.

Will the wave of time come to an end? Born again, I had to go someplace. Born of the Spirit, I have entered eternal life. "To know God is to know eternal life." I exhort everyone to walk in holiness, for such is God's kingdom. We are what we eat, as in time there is a choice between good and evil, whereas in eternity there is only the best of good while naturally in the Christ. He is in us within the purity of His living resurrection bloodline of life. We will be in Him, and He will be in us as one. "Be ye holy as I am holy," For one day we shall know Him as He is when we see Him face to face within His time, and as He is the truth, there will be no more guesstimating.

One day, time will run out in this realm, "Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall never pass away." Then there will be either a kingdom of love where "To the pure all things are pure," in eternal life, or an eternal damnation of only abusive company.

When we practice what we understand, we are in eternity, for we have grown into an existence of good or evil. At the end of our lives, "We reap what we sow." So, depending on how we decide to follow God's plan of salvation, we will be granted access to His circle of love or not. I chose to enter into eternity from time by the doorway of the blood of Jesus Christ, who is hanging on His Holy Cross to let in eternal light for as long as it will last on earth as true light cuts through time.

Eternity

The Bible says: "Seek peace and pursue it." Time is to motion as eternity is to rest. So, we must slow down beyond the commotion found in time to have peace for perspective in the light of eternal life. I've learned to put anything that has my sight on pause to see if it has the kind of love greater than the light of Christ. When something gets dismissed as second best compared to knowing the love of Christ, it grows stale before going pale compared to the glory of God's eternal life.

Regarding sin, another scripture says, "To have thought it is to have done it." If "Godliness with contentment is great gain," and "God is slow to act as a thousand years is to a day and a day as a thousand years with the Lord," is it possible that in His stillness, God does everything through His thoughts, going out from the centrality of none motion into motion as the root of a spiritual tree? Could this then create the motion in His circular cycle of love to light to life and then back to His regenerative resurrection blood, which flows as a pool into a fountain of balance to hold all in its place?

In case anyone is wondering, how is it possible that I am sharing this vision? God caught me by His mercy to show me around and experience being in His presence firsthand.

Will God ever die? The scriptures say that "God is a God of the living and not the dead." I see the elements of His essence as a perpetual state of being in suspended animation on a deeper level than I understand right now.

Rather than go into a speculative guesstimate that would deprive me of my peace where I would be exceeding my growth rate to saw off my branch from His vine, I will continue to be still. I will heed God's voice that says it is not safe for Him to disclose or for me

to pursue this answer as the scripture says, "To what depths have you fallen from the heavens, O morning star, son of the dawn!" If God wants to reveal this answer to me, I can wait for His time as I enjoy His kingdom and respect His boundaries. "Love never fails" to reach from eternity into time.

Child Rearing

I had no direction in social skills in my life; I do not blame my parents, for they could only do the best that they knew. Yet, as "God works all things out for good for those who love Him," I believe that my early prayers of concern for Him in Hebrew School opened a path toward me finding Him at the core of His being.

For every action, there is an equal and opposite reaction. I believe that God as Creator either wired me to be who I am to show Him compassion on How busy He must be or that my childlike faith in prayer was honored by Him. "Unless you have the faith of a little child, you will in no wise enter the kingdom of God." Looking back, I can see how He sent an angel to guide me home to Him throughout my life through His Spirit. Fortunately, my parents had sent me to Hebrew School to learn about Him. By seeing how God interacts and treats others throughout the Bible, I feel secure in honoring Him.

There are patterns in the home that children pick up on through the osmosis of family dynamics. Once out of Hebrew School, I forgot about God and gravitated towards observations of how my family and friends lived on life's terms in the world. A heritage of the atmosphere of family and peers is something I tried to copy, but my not being who God made me be left me dazed, confused, and in the dark. Feeling insecure, I learned that children took care of themselves, and that was good enough for me until I realized that the truth about who I was was missing inside.

Frozen without any love to know myself in an esteeming way, I was left clueless about who I was. Isaiah 42:3: "He will not break a bruised reed, nor will he snuff out a smoldering wick; faithfully he will establish justice."

God had not forgotten me. I can see He guided me to pause, ponder, and search for His light in my darkness. I started to learn his voice, and now I hear it loud and clear: "Do not cheat on me!" If it does not look like God, He is not there.

I am aware that different behavior patterns are passed down through different generations. However, if behaviors veer from the truth of God, they bend and twist reality into distortions. You must practice what you fully understand, choose darkness over God's light, and put yourself out of existence with Him. Then, while He is not there, lying spirits that live in darkness will take control of your life. For in the absence of celebrating the truth of God loving you, all manner of dragons will manifest themselves.

I recall being bored and looking for something to do. Someone planted the thought in my mind to find a hobby. Later, when I discovered the thrill of a hobby that only lasted for a season after I learned the truth, I realized that it was only a deception that distracted me from God. If you don't know what a gun is or how to drive a car, chances are you're going to have an accident eventually and incur death or great harm. Guesstimating a life instead of knowing what it is all about is just as dangerous. If the world was a random place without being planned, could it have lasted this long?

By truth becoming my mother, replacing the confusion of lies, all finally became clear. My heart and mind gradually grew together so that my focus could be healed as a mature person in God's love. I am now aware that the Spirit or spirits truly parent us within the minds of all to draw us nearer or further away from God. "There is a way that seems right unto a man, but in the end, it only leads to death."

Guesstimating's End

One fully exists when one practices what one understands in Spirit and truth. In this world's time-based realm, there are many spirits, but in the whole of creation, only one unified Holy Spirit guides us to meet a very real Jesus Christ. God, meeting with our focus means that we are not guessing with a faith that is blind, "For when the blind lead the blind, the two fall into a ditch." A ditch to me is the valley of the shadow of death, which I believe is this world as everybody dies of death.

When people hate and abuse, love becomes a foreign land. When one stops hating, they know they have changed because they can taste the sweetness of God's love in its place.

In order not to guesstimate, you have to "Study to show yourself approved." If you were to buy a used car, would you not want to know all about it beforehand, or would you just guess that you could afford the gas, possible repairs, and auto insurance expenses? You would want to know the mileage or if it was ever in an accident. Look under the hood, check the hoses for wear, and check the maintenance reports, or possibly take it to a mechanic for inspection after a test drive.

Before I opened my online bookstore at <u>calingtoncastle.com</u>, I checked the traffic to my website, found the best theme for the layout, organized it, and figured out the cost of how long it could be maintained. I then figured out the advertising expenses and the risks of opening a business that would change it from a hobby to a profession. I also ensured that I was doing everything right by God, my main business partner, and the team of people He brought into my life to make things happen.

In this same light, "Salvation" should be studied until the only choice is to live it out. I came to this conclusion from people around me who thought it was up to them beyond trusting in God's words to try and fix or rule this world.

Guesstimating happens when we try to fit God's world into ours rather than join Him in eternal life, for we've become used to surviving in this world rather than trusting to thrive with God in His kingdom of eternal life. For it's not about our way of life, but living in the sanctuary of God on His celestial shores as "We are now in the world, but no longer of it." Spiritually, the aroma and breath of life in God's kingdom is better than what the world offers. So, being content with the spiritual heritage of His Kingdom rather than what this world has to offer, I choose God's words of prophecy overall as they have proven themselves true.

I am grateful for being delivered from a seductive world of darkness. I now choose to reject what sounded good to me to please my flesh and pride of life for the doorway of Christ's cross. I see that I need to be seasoned with the Spirit of the living God and not the spirits of this world anymore. "For if the salt should lose its flavor, it is good for nothing."

This world is evil because it has invisible bars of darkness that distract from the God of light. You cannot escape the prison of this world with lies but only the truth of God. Remember that there is a death sentence in this fallen world due to Adam's sin, where he cut himself off from the living God by listening to darkness and cheating on Him.

There is no more guesstimating because I enjoy the character of the Holy Spirit in me, which has ushered Jesus Christ in me more than loving my creature self.

Thank God for His mercy and grace, which has brought me to Himself by grafting me into drawing from His vine. He called, and I answered. I shall continue to watch as He carries me through in His strength, after all, is this not what makes Him the most high and powerful God?

Are we living a best guess as to what life is all about? According to everyone else around us, we seem to have things right. There are times when I feel uneasy inside and wonder where I am.

What does God say in the stillness of His voice, which is often overlooked by the noise of this world? The scripture says, "We are to do everything as unto the Lord." Although, what does this mean?

So many people around us are distant from God with a darkened melancholy chorus, making it hard to sing with The Almighty as our choice. This is where we guess how to live instead of what God has planned out as best for our lives.

Hearing God can be confusing at first till instability comes to an end from guesstimating life.
