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Where Are You?

We are in the breadth, a testing ground between two worlds of time and eternity. Depending on our choices, we are drawn towards either of these two worlds in progressive stages of growth. Yet how can one discern for certain whose army they shall belong to at the end of their life while being purged in the breadth of God?

“You reap what you sow.” If we sow towards the winds found in the instabilities of time, we are broken down and assimilated into a spiritual food source of energy. For “Everything that can be shaken will be shaken so that which will remain will remain.” If we find and remain where nothing is shaken anymore, then we have seen the stability of the eternal, where our energy becomes retained in eternal life.

“Be still and know that I am God.” In stillness, we are at rest on God’s firm foundation and here we grow in our relationship with Him as “To know God is to know eternal life.” This happens on the many levels of being rooted and grounded in the love of God as He extends downward His roots. “All of creation testifies of God.”

We are uprooted from the abyss by God’s Spirit. It shoots us upward past all earthly pleasures till out of the angel of darkness disguised as an angel of light’s clutches beyond all worldly atmospheric heights as well.

When we don’t know God, we are in various stages of incongruity. So, until we are slowed to see that after passing through the commotion of motion, there is no release from out of the dim and into the light of Christ. After experiencing friction and heat, there was no real freedom before until we were beyond all dark flames. For without affection towards a bond of contentment with the love of God that leads to life in a full relationship with Him, the letter kills and leaves us without the Holy Spirit of life, which is poured out through the door of Jesus Christ between the darkness of confusion and the stability of light. Remember that there is the Circle of regenerative living blood, which cycles in a return of the resurrection back through the light that is created from the generative fervency of the door of God's love. For as "Mercy triumphs over judgment," we will either hate what darkness brings into our soul or love the other kingdom of light, as being devoted to one, we will then despise the other. "You cannot serve God and mammon (and a self-serving attitude in which we carry out our affairs) at the same time."

Jesus said about Himself, "Unless a grain of wheat dies and falls, it cannot be planted in the ground." Our actions and spoken words must yield power for creation towards receiving His seed of regenerative resurrection by living blood. His lineage of having no motion found in the light of eternal life while at peace gives us

perspective for direction, or we will release our stored energy, transferring it over to the compulsion of the winds. When behaving compulsively, we feed demon powers while doing things in our timing, for we choose to enter into motion and give our strength away. Minions hover around the breadth, a testing ground that passes through the wave of the forward motion of time to see if we shall call on God or rely on ourselves. When relying on ourselves, we allow unholy spirits to enter and rise from our gut till we speak them out in an unrighteous manner to inherit death and not life.

“Seek peace and pursue it,” and speaking at peace allows us to conserve energy. When talking to God, who is “our ever-present help in time of need,” as “we are seated in heavenly places with Christ Jesus,” just as long as we keep our peace. Jesus goes into battle for us, and here He preserves our joy so that we remain delivered, as “The joy of the Lord is our strength.”

“We are to take every thought captive unto the subjection of Jesus Christ,” as He is our King and champion. The King of Kings has been set in authority to rule over us and defend us when we know His presence so we can call on Him. At all other times, God watches over us through His mercy and protects us while we learn to grow in the knowledge of His grace.

“Pray without ceasing,” as this allows us to focus through all darkness to remain in the light and life of Jesus Christ. In this way, as our focus becomes greater, we are given sight to see what is hiding in the darkness and ask God to remove it upon request, for you cannot be refashioned from darkness into light to see what’s going on with sight without the brilliance from the true light of eternal life.

You can tell which army you’re in when you’re still and in your place, as the darkness of motion’s compulsiveness will subside when you see clearly to know where you are. We practice what we do not

understand and live a deceptive lie otherwise, as with stability, there are no variables to dim a sight. All else is the confusion of darkness and a great loss. "May the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, guard your hearts and minds."

A Single Mind is a Sound Mind

“Blessed are the pure in heart for they shall see God.”

Pure means 100% committed and without any obstacles in the way to block an intimacy of oneness with God. A vessel of honor contains the Spirit of the living God without any shadow of shifting. A vessel of dishonor is a broken vessel with many holes, a polluted cistern that allows other spirits to rest until they feel comfortable enough to nest and eventually take up a stronghold of residence. “If you lose your life for my namesake, you’ll find it.”

God has a timing for all things to grow into place within His proper orchestration. It is a symphony of truth with the precision that allows all to awaken by choice to suit, to will, and do His good pleasure at the appointed times. We essentially die to come alive.

Healed Through Scripture

“Faith is the substance of things hoped for and the evidence of things not seen” vision remains incongruous until there is a complete focus on another stage of growth from being stilled for greater vision. Until focus allows you to see across the great divide into the properties of the parallel universe where in lies the divine, “A double-minded man is unstable in all His ways and let Him not believe that he shall receive anything from God.” When the mind is still, and in the quiet of rest, it has a single vision to hear and receive God’s voice, along with all His promises.

I have noted that spiritual touches from God affect my physical body as He is the light and the life of all men. “You draw nigh unto me, and I shall draw nigh unto you,” says the Lord. God’s Kingdom is a place of eternal life, and I have been brought to understand that when His kingdom scriptures are interpreted correctly, we draw close enough for a spiritual resurrection that affects us physically. Here is an example of how God multiplies His presence for a change to occur within the atmosphere's essence when having faith. Pay attention to what happens through the prophet Elijah.

"So he arose and went to Zarephath. When he arrived at the gate to the city, a woman was there who was a widow. She was gathering sticks, and he called out to her and said, 'Bring me a little water in a jar so that I can have something to drink.'

"As she went to get it for him, he called out to her and said, 'Please also bring me a bit of bread in your hand.' But she told him, 'As the Lord, your God, lives, I do not have any bread. I only have a handful of flour in a jar and some oil in a jug. I am gathering two sticks so that I can prepare it for myself and my son so that we can eat it and die.'

Elijah said to her, 'Do not be afraid. Go and do what you have

said, but first, make a small piece of bread and bring it to me.' Afterward, you can make some for yourself and your son. For thus says the Lord, the God of Israel, 'The jar of flour will not be used up, the jug of oil will not go dry, up until the day that the LORD sends rain upon the earth.'

She went and did what Elijah had told her to do. She, he, and her household ate for a long time. The jar of flour was not used up, and the jug of oil did not go dry, just as the word of the LORD had foretold through Elijah."

Just as God's word used Elijah as a willing host to work through Him, so too do we, according to being vessels of honor or dishonor with our actions and words. Every dot and every tittle is being recorded to reveal the true nature of our being. We must examine the intent of our hearts and thoughts coming together daily by measuring our natural spiritual growth rate on earth as it is in heaven. Or, we may find ourselves off balance and joining an army of darkness rather than light.

We could essentially adhere to the old expression, "You're getting on my nerves." We are created in God's image, and when we get on His nerves, He is patient with us through the perfect mercy of His passion for us. A part of His mercy is that when we do the wrong thing by Him, as He is very sensitive, there are reactions in our bodies as we are joined to Him and simultaneously separated. My pains happen when I get on God's nerves by doing the wrong thing; I can feel it in my bones. This pain is also a part of His mercy because it allows all to turn back to Him by calling on Him day and night if we have to until He answers. "We've been praying through for a night, but joy comes in the morning."

If you have reason to call out to God, then call. Weep and wail and moan until you find the answer to what God is trying to tell you.

You may be holding onto a stumbling block that not only hinders your spiritual growth but can also affect you physically. Then repent, turn back to Him again, and be right while on His path. For by every action and spoken word, we create a reaction of peace or chaos and join ourselves to one or the other of these two spiritual armies.

We are all deeply connected to God unless we sever ourselves from Him by rejecting the truth of His love, as this is abusive, and abuse is of a kingdom other than love. We grow line upon line by a desire of intention or by taking the Holy Eucharist directly. "Blessed are those who hunger and thirst after righteousness, for they shall be satisfied." God reacts according to what lines up with His virtuous Character of light, or we go into and with the confusion of darkness and Satan's abuse by choice.

John 3:16: "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son that none should perish, but all have everlasting life with Him." Friend, what will your choice be today, tomorrow, and forevermore?
