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## Off in the Distance

## The Search

As a small child, I was sent to Hebrew school. From the little I learned about God at age five, I would talk to Him with the concern of how busy He must be.

After going through school, I got to sit in the main congregation at last. I had heard about all His works in the bible and now I was going to actually meet Him. Having been Bar Mitzvahed, I was ready to take my place in the community. Though after sitting among others and seeing them fall asleep to the left and right of me while the Rabbi spoke, there was just no fire of His presence there. So, I left and soon forgot everything.

Much later on, it was as though I was hearing about God for the first time again, but this time as the butt end of a joke. For, when I was asked, "Do you believe in God?" in an unsettling way, I answered from a vision of a picture I had seen in my synagogue that he was a tree to much sneering laughter.

I was too clueless to be skeptical about Him at this point in my life as I had many issues that prevented me from focusing my thoughts beyond a dark fog. Yet intrigued about hearing about something new, I decided I needed to learn more. Although, among many distractions that seemed to come along within my thoughts, I soon lost interest again.

Drunk in bad spirits where I walked as dead, bored, and not high on life with a bunch of other teen derelicts in a park, an evangelist approached us, and again I heard about God. After a while, I recognized the one who was professing about God as the old terror of the neighborhood and was so impressed that I listened to his every word. This was the first time I had ever heard about Jesus Christ and although I didn't understand everything he was saying,

his complete change in attitude was what caught my attention. I wanted to know more and soon after, I went to many protestant churches. In one of them, during a sermon, a tear broke through my numb-comfortable exterior and I knew that God was real, but still, I didn't know Him. So I got lost in religion as I began to practice what I did not understand.

## **A First Touch**

I didn't understand what was happening to me, but after that first touch, I wanted more of what was real. However, one touch not being everything, I went back to that church looking for a second and when it didn't happen I began my journey of church hopping and exploring other religions.

Sitting in different churches, I met many different kinds of people from different walks of life, but then I started to notice a disconnect between the shepherds and the flock.

"This is my commandment that you love one another as I have loved you so that your joy may be full." This was a scripture that seemed to stick, but what was love really? Everybody seemed to treat each other nicely, though something seemed to be missing.

Looking back in hindsight through mature eyes, what was missing was deep and intimate love. Make no mistake, love has many layers to it. Shallow people will attract other shallow people, but when, "We love because God first loved us," with an understanding that, "The deep calls unto the deep," you'll understand what is meant by, "If you search for Me with all your heart, you will find Me."

Intimate love has the patience to suffer long and endure the shortcomings of others. "He who forgives little loves little and he who forgives much, loves much." Therefore God would have to have perfect patience to have endured the cross, knowing that it would produce fruit in others in the future. Because God has perfect peace, the scripture that says, "The peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus," is a testimony that answers His truth. The God of peace is in us when we have peace and therefore, when we have peace, we must be in His kingdom as He is the King of peace. When there is commotion in our

lives and don't have peace we are being shaken apart from God in another kingdom.

“Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God.” I knew that I hadn't met God or seen him, so what could be wrong with my heart that I did not see Him? I understand now. I had to forgive the world for all the abuse that was thrown at me. I realize that I even abused myself. Taking it in without understanding what was happening prevented me from loving in a sincere way. Jesus said from the cross, “Forgive them Father for they know not what they do,” in order to turn the tide of the murderous hate so that it would become a joy to endure it out of love for us.”

“We are to be rooted and grounded in the love of God.” Where is God and how was I going to receive His love without being able to see Him? Then I realized that I was hearing about Him in scripture and started to recognize that He was introducing himself through scripture or perhaps something more. “All of creation testifies of God.” In order to be rooted and grounded, I would have to have started out as a seed. So I noticed that creation must have a message about the creator, too. Yet the scriptures came from the Spirit of the living God, so I would have to study both. Yes, I see. “Study to show yourself approved.”

## Bible Treasures

God gets acquainted with us as we begin to read with the understanding that we as the church bride are being adorned for Jesus our bridegroom by a refashioning within us with His own flesh and blood.

I have learned that in studying the scriptures, there's a difference between using a mind of flesh and a mind guided by the Holy Spirit in comprehending scripture with the wisdom of God. "It's the Holy Spirit that is the leader and guide into all truth."

Jesus said to Pontius Pilot, "I came to bear witness of the truth." Pontius replied, "What is truth?" Knowledge of the world has a quick reaction to puff up in pride and will leave you in and of this world. However, the wisdom of God will allow you to see the light of Jesus Christ as the truth and take you into eternal life. For, "We are to walk in the light while we have the light that darkness does not overtake us."

There are two ways of telling if scripture is being interpreted correctly. Am I being drawn closer to Jesus in a relationship with Him by the renewing of my mind? Or am I being conformed to remain in this world within its views? The other is, does one profess that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh? For me, it is what I interpret as living flesh and blood according to Kosher law, which states that blood has to be drained from the meat. Kashrut, the Jewish dietary law, governs the process by which meat is made kosher. It forbids the blood of an animal from being consumed because doing so is equated with eating a living animal which is another Jewish dietary prohibition. While most blood is drained during the slaughtering process, the remaining blood is dealt with through kashering. I see this as being a foreshadowing sign of things to come.

I believe that this was a sign that the Messiah, Jesus Christ, would have a bloodline that could sustain us eternally. The Holy Eucharist contains such a bloodline to sustain any who feed on earth as it is in heaven, whether by intention or directly upon Him. “Blessed are those who hunger and thirst after righteousness for they shall be satisfied.” Jesus also said, “For unless you eat of my flesh and drink of my blood, you will have no life in you.” This is a gift of grace, for all who desire Him. “Our Father who art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Give us this day our daily bread . . .”

Now whereas Adam’s bloodline dies due to sin, Jesus has the bloodline of eternal life as it knew no corruption of sin. Being pure with eternal blood, He was able to rise from the dead. For the impurities of this realm have no hold on a pure bloodline without sin. The Messiah, in accomplishing this task, was able to pierce time’s darkness and all abuse to enter back into eternity. For, Jesus said that as the light and life of all men, “I am the way, the truth, and the life and no man comes to the Father but by Me.”

## Doors

I've learned that according to the prophet Joel in the Old Testament, "Your young men will have visions and your old men will dream dreams," is accurate from first-hand experience. In one such vision, I got caught up in the high hall of heaven by the Holy Spirit. It unfolded to me in a gradual reveal as it impressed upon my mind that there is a commingling of regenerative living blood in a bond of love between the Father and the Son. While experiencing their blissful love, from out of the bond, its fervency came generating friction, turning to heat beyond fire, and then into light as a fountain that created all things to sustain life. The scripture then came to me that "Jesus Christ is the light and the life of all men."

I was blessed by seeing this vision and experiencing their core love. I say core because out of this centrality came a structure of a circling cycle of order, which went out from its center and returned back. It's a fountain of regenerative resurrection that flowed out to return again.

Now outside of this regenerative cycle of the resurrection of the light and life of all men, came a circle of rebellion where an insurrection of darkness, without any stable structure is taking place. I make mention of these two cycling circles because just as Adam fell from love, light, and life, he opened a door into the darkness of circling confusion of a kingdom having no stability, which led to death. Except for the mercy of the testing ground of the breadth, mankind would have been lost in darkness forever.

Being the door back into the light, Jesus allows us to grow progressively in a relationship with Him from out of the darkness and cross back into the depth of brilliant love. His stand against all wrongdoing was His quest. His purpose as the second Adam was

fulfilled, by His righteous calling to counter all unrighteousness. Jesus Christ was chosen to be the anointed one throughout all time, even until this day, and beyond.

In reading scripture, I've noted that there are doors through which we grow into the light of an eternal realm whenever we identify with the characters who Jesus meets in the pages of the bible. Each one of these doors allows us to establish a base of stability and grow, "Line upon line, precept upon precept, here a little and there a little," up into knowing God in eternal life. For, "To know God is to know eternal life."

## **Building Relationships**

“Remember me, Jesus, when You’ve come into Your kingdom,” were the words of a thief dying next to the King of glory. While both of their lives hung in the balance, Jesus responded, “This day you shall be with Me in paradise.” With the exchange of these few words, a life long relationship was started of an eternal nature. I am reminded of how little my father and I spoke to each other on an emotional level due to this.

My earthly father came from a stoic generation in Europe where children were to be seen and not heard. So, to no fault of his own, a roof over his head, clothes on the back, and food on the table was all there was to give. There were no emotional ties involved because he was clueless about their existence.

I can remember my dad just being my dad off in the distance. I knew he was there, but I never knew him. From what I knew, not knowing him was knowing him. There was no bond of love with any depth as our hearts were never knit together. Because of this fact, I became a stranger in a very strange land. A life without love left me in a free fall. I watched everything as an observer and never connected with others as I existed outside of relationships.

A healthy picture of intimacy did not exist either as my dad would only talk at me and not to me. Love and truth were so out of balance that it skewed my perception of life to the point of not being able to comprehend my boundaries or those of others and this set me up to be overrun. Without a boundary of love, you can’t tell where love is or not which leaves one defenseless around others who want to take advantage of you.

Until I came to know God in a personal way over many years, I had no idea of what intimacy was in a relationship. For I had no one

to guide me, and lacking emotional intelligence, I was up for grabs while guesstimating my way through life.

Jesus laid everything out for me because He proved His Father to be trustworthy in the way He related to Him. His Father had a plan, and the way He followed Him achieved results. Do right by God, The Father of Creation, and He will do right by you. It was here in this light that I found the substance which gave me purpose for living. When I realized that He had to do the work to change me to do right, I picked up my pen and served Him with it.

In John 3:16, "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son that none should perish, but all have everlasting life with Him," I found sanity in a community of love. Just as Jesus had a relationship with His disciples and they learned of Him as they watched Him in a relationship with His Father, through their eyes, I learned that I could trust, too.

Unfortunately, we are born into this world without the relationship with God that we were originally created to have. This leaves us incomplete and clueless as to truly relate with others. It is impossible, as I've learned to comprehend it. To have a healthy relationship with ourselves without first having a normal relationship with our Maker and Creator leaves us in limbo. It's like someone asking you the time when you've not yet learned how to tell time; you're told where the clock is but are unable to respond. In the same way, God is known only by name, and you miss the concept of His character which leaves you remaining distant from others.

In a parallel state of being, others lack the full concept of the depth of God's power to move within His timing to bring intimacy by entering into a relationship with respect to boundaries. But those who learn of His character can draw progressively closer as they grow nearer to become warm. They now reach out to grow inwardly

as they desire depth in understanding God. Christ now lights the way for us to follow to remedy situations that have grown cold, and He, being in the flesh, knows how to initiate a relationship with us.

By the truth of His Spirit of love, all is revealed to us as all relationships are of a spiritual nature. So when inviting the Living Father of all spirits, He marries and brings joy while entering within us, and we with Him. Jesus came to have a relationship with all who accept Him, and this is what He came to accomplish. Most people don't understand the big picture of God's plan to share all His wealth of creation with us. He came to transform us into the image of His loving Son. We become sidetracked instead and relate with our own little figuring corners, never to realize that we're lacking in the wealth of God whose riches are to be found within Himself by wisdom. He is always extending His open hands to bring us out of the chaotic corners of doing things our own way when we could be speaking within the focus of knowing our words count to the sum total of joyously living God's way. This should aid in sharing His life within us with others and keep us on the right path, but the deflection of the devil invades our thoughts.

People remain religiously poor without realizing why as they have blind dysfunctional illusions in place of God's liberating light, which robs them of eternal life in the Spirit while here on earth. On the other hand, don't assume that someone who appears religious knows how to relate to others. It's only when we recognize the completion of our Lord's truth in each stage of our growth that things begin to come into focus as a full body of believers. This is when we come together as a body in love despite the differences of our shortcomings. God draws all unto Himself, despite our backgrounds, as a part of the proof that He is real.

Turn to God's steadfast protection of Himself and discover a relationship of loving acceptance that will truly last. Yet, signals get crossed with people as you hear what they say, but their actions dictate another reality that deviates from revealing all falsehoods as discernment is learned. Even if we break ties with Him, His love endures until all the darkness of our poor choosings are weeded out till we remain in sincerity. "For the shepherd leaves the ninety-nine and goes after the lost sheep" and when found, all of heaven rejoices when the sheep is returned to the fold. Trust God a little more of what you believe you're responsible for each day and your faith in a relationship with Him will grow until there is only life in place of strife.

Coming out of learned behaviors of abuse, which sparked us to be rebels, makes it hard to learn of God's unfailing love. Then, how do we learn to do it? We must study to find the truth and show ourselves approved. While reading scripture, we must continue to grow to understand God more, for He has an established pattern built on a firm foundation that brings all of stability to sanity with a clear mind. Contentment then comes to satisfy a soul. The tide of confusion found in darkness withdraws from unsound spirits. Then, left with the Holy Spirit for healing to take place where confusion had taken its toll, we are comforted because the joy of the Lord becomes our strength.

It's not about giving things up to gain acceptance, which can spark rebellion, either. It's about growing to love Christ more so we can relate to Him in a way we are carried in His will. The greater our affection towards Him, the more loving we become. Then God restores the harm done to us by filling in our hurts with the love of His affections, and we are freed from our hardships.

Our past melts away and we are found to start afresh in the enjoyment of our new relationships with others, as now we have an increased value of depth within our souls, all by God's doing.

Whenever our past structures light up within our thoughts, we can now turn to Christ's loving brilliance within our lives and ask them to be removed as they're a hindrance that blocks deeper relations with Him. I am being instructed in the way of God's pattern, directing me towards making better choices. Not only am I disinterested in my old ways of doing things, but I am no longer found alone as was in the case of my own self-efforts.

Although we were in God's structure of grace, we were still unable to connect with Him while in past patterns of abusive survival modes. Then we found God's forgiveness to love us into a more complete existence I'm still growing into while trusting Jesus, The Christ.

Now, as past hurts arise, turn your memories over to God, and more healing will come. For where God is present, that's where it's Holy. Sound-mindedness of stability then comes when walking on Holy Ground. "For to be absent from the body is to be present with the Lord," and here in God's kingdom while on earth, you will be protected from demonic spirits by God's Holy Spirit, for we are in this world and no longer of it.

Our Christ, who's the Son of the image of His own regenerative blood Father, now holds your future, and this is where growth and perpetual healing take place. Ghosts of self-reflection exit here, leaving more unoccupied room for God to draw near, which keeps the ghosts from returning to haunt.

In Him, in the light of His brilliance, we can patiently see that he's been there with us throughout it all, making bonding with Him even more complete. He invites us to come to Him and go beyond

resting in our struggles. When we call upon Him, The Lord God Almighty keeps His promises, “He [has, and is, and is going to] deliver us from all of our afflictions.” The love God has to share has been found, as He is always extending Himself lavishly toward us. The very essence of His being commingles with us by His own regenerative blood. The love of Him sparks forth even more revelation with light, now stretch and grow in Spirit and in Truth.

When we’re sent from home each day, we represent our father from a long lineage of growth. What we’ve been taught will display the substance of the relationship with our ancestors, for better or worse. Know this: any relationship not built on Christ’s actions of love and His words of truth joined together in balance is destined to fail. Anything not established on absolute truth will fall short of eternity and land one in the relativity of time.

I discovered I was lacking when Jesus showed me by His grace to learn of Him. Then, by examining my relationship with Him, little by little, I asked Him to change me. I am changed to glorify God, knowing that as I look at my hand it is Him who not only made me, but He is the one refashioning my identity into something beautiful as I relate to Him. I feel His substance within my character and as I sense it, I am being made more alive than I ever thought possible.

I am now filled with His substance that makes me want to reach out and touch others in a respectful, honest, and loving manner. I have discovered compassionate transforming love as this is how Jesus first reached out to me. His truth and love continually give off light for sight. I can now build and experience real relationships through the power of His might; whereas in the past, I would lock myself into misconceived ideas of others and the patterns of my own shortcomings. Now that I have Jesus as my role model to pray to, I have better transformative answers.

God only requires that I have peace with Him in accordance with His word and not let anything grow without His stability being there. God loves us patiently and encourages us with Himself as our example, for He knows that He has the substance that we feed on for life, which is with Himself and the adorning of His words. Learning to read and digest them at the proper pace, not too fast or slow, allows us enough time to be satisfied, for we can better relate to Him by growing at a balanced pace.

God's Spirit of adoption makes us one with Him, and I am seen when He looks on with agreement as His own beloved Son as I am being infused with His regenerative blood. I am His growing child, and as I look up to the reality of heavenly light, drawing nearer with a learned anticipation of discovery, I find I know my Lord, and my place is before Him as He resides on His throne. I'm finding the precious truth of His love in a confident place within my heart, where I'm found to converse with Him in almost all of my affairs. God sometimes is so near to me that I even hear myself talking out loud to Him. I've learned of my worth by knowing who God is and as a temple of the Holy Spirit, I am consumed with Christ. I know God, for by His Spirit of truth and grace, He dwells in me and causes my face to shine. In His presence is fullness of joy.

Relationships take time to develop; Christ calls to us through our conscience through His Holy Spirit. We are now shaking off the minion spirits from out of darkness and growing to further meet Christ within His light. Each time we humble ourselves before Him with the acknowledgment of His better way, I can hear His voice over mine, and then I am guided.

So, don't try to figure out what to do next with your old mind of flesh. If you remain at peace, you shall eventually have light from God's Spirit to ignite your thoughts with sight, and then you will

know what direction to take in life. "Be still and know that I am God," and when you are, you can communicate with Him effectively. His voice builds a relationship that teaches His way of life. God is with us through all of our trials, as proven by His commitment to sculpt us at a loving pace. He is faithful and as we discover our new inner beauty, we know our value as we reflect His character within us as seen by our new natures.

God fills my soul as an invited spiritual lover, and I gush out as a river of life to all who are thirsty. It's not how I see myself any longer now, as my desire is for the Lord, and His desire is mine. Just as the Ark of the Covenant was the power center and substance of all Israel, when we bear the name of "Christian," we bear it as Arks of Christ, whose same power is within us as He is our hope of glory. God holds our substance as we relate with Him in a Holy and respectfully reverent manner, which keeps us lit and away from the darkness while on the Holy path of grace.

Jesus said, "I am the light of the world." The way a torch would lead us in a dark breezy cave, He steadies and suffers us to remain on the path. We cherish the light as it guides us away from the jagged edges of the walls that we cannot see in the dark. Christ, as our torch fires from within, leads us to the best place He wants us to be, "A broken and contrite heart He will not cast out." Here, God keeps us humbly pure, sensitive, and faithful as "God's strength is perfected in our weakness."

Jesus forgives repentant hearts, and the redeemer of our souls restores and heals us. Is the substance of your truth real, or does it cave under the pressure of abuse by the oppressor? The truth of God's substance carries us through the dark, for we cannot carry ourselves or find our way through it. For our God can deliver all who know that they're not God. Jesus Christ has my gaze, which causes

me to see beyond all else, even into the future, as I believe the promise of His words.

I've truly received the Spirit of God's love, for my heart is genuinely warm towards others and not cold. A cold heart is unmoved and rejects God by choosing the lesser spirit of a lie where one is kept lonely and hollow inside. I am now attentive to listening to the Spirit of His new life from within. I will never forget about the person who saved my life, even though on some level I shout crucify Him because I am not completely without sin. My mind is sound and I cannot deny the work God's done within. I have become His family and desire to do His will. For I am with Him who gives me a state of presence and being a part of it.

I learned by the Lord's standard that "Man looks on the outer appearance, but God looks at the heart." This revelation came next: *A relationship between God and others works best with honest self-disclosure.*

In a setting where everyone can reveal their inner self, thoughts and emotions allow the healing of feelings to come together. Listening to others is so important. By allowing expressions to come forth, we can actually watch others heal in the light of the truth of them coming together. For in a safe environment, they can balance out to become more stable with loving acceptance. Seeing God's principles of structure come into play is also a real faith builder because the longer a person talks, the freer they become as their focus moves out of darkness towards light. "You will know the truth, and the truth will set you free."

"A laborer is worthy of His hire." For when watching, listening, and praying, the observer also thaws out by identifying with healing feelings. You've found a friend when you're loved and accepted for

the honesty of who you are, without the other person expecting anything in return.

All revelation should come out of a love for the truth. Just as Jesus Christ is in a relationship with knowing His Father, God wants to reveal Himself, too. Drawing near to Him, we're given a clear perception of how to ask for the grace we need to be transformed. The divine fruits of the Spirit give us new eternal choices in our lives so that we may grow in a relationship with an abundance of life, the kind that God has intended for us all.

## **Bearing Spiritual Fruits**

You cannot plant a seed in a hurricane; the winds must first subside. God said, "Be still and know that I am God." Stillness sparks friction which turns to heat, until fire is ignited to go against dark motion, for while we are still and against such motion, we match God's kingdom of light to enter in.

In darkness, there is confusion as the devil is the author of it; that is why we are to "Walk in the light while you have the light so darkness does not overtake you."

Satan is the Prince of darkness where there's chaos through deception. This dragon wants to drag you around and deplete you of your energy by keeping your mind in dark motion so that you can hear its lying voice. For when your desires are fleshly, you will suit this devil's purpose, which is to rob you of your relationship with a tender loving God who is able to meet all your needs. The devil wants to own your thought life to possess your mind with its own and edge God out. "Man plans, but God laughs" at our feeble attempts to find comfort in a cesspool with a stench that reaches high heaven, except for the prayers of His children, which releases incense to Him. Remember, Adam was sent here to "work by the sweat of his brow" until he died; that sounds like a prison to me.

God is sad for those who are self-deceived into believing that this fallen world is some kind of a utopia when, in fact, it is a testing ground for us to realize its distaste and cry out to Him for deliverance. Those who persevere to find answers with all their hearts will find Him. "If you search for me with all your heart, you will find Me." For God had said, "I'd rather you were hot or cold, for the lukewarm I will spew out of my mouth." Remember, misery loves company. So awake you slothful, who are just getting by when your

focus could be more fervently on the God who is in this world and no longer of it. You know who you are.

Are you in this camp: Praying without ceasing, studying to show yourself approved, singing sweet songs and melodies with spiritual hymns that glorify God with your whole heart? Do you look up and know the vine you're connected to, or redeem the time because the days are evil? "Look up for your redemption draws near," as you are no longer of this world.

Take inventory now and examine the fruit you bear, as it does not fall far from the tree. There is also a deceptive way of being cold. So be sure to remember that "Our righteousness is as filthy rags," or you might end up a fourth part of the Godhead and betray yourself by lying to God.

## Cycle of Resurrection Love

Does anybody know when resurrection life is supposed to happen or what it is? Jesus said, "I am the resurrection and the life, he that believes in me, though he were dead yet shall he live." He said this just before He physically raised Lazareth from the dead. Yet, did He mean something more than just raising the dead? I mean, how exactly was he raised from the dead, and is there a spiritual way of being raised from the dead as well as a physical one? Is there a spiritual resurrection before a physical one? First, we must understand what resurrection is to know what we believe.

First, I'm going to explain how we are in a reverse resurrection due to abuse, and then how this cycle is broken through a return to love.

God's judgment was to preserve the solid foundation of peace in heaven by having man leave due to his disobedience, which caused a commotion that disrupted stillness. At physical birth, we enter into a physical world and grow to experience our surroundings. However, after experiencing everything there is physically, when not being able to be still for very long or settling down starts to set in, a spiritual wind of motion sets in. Like drifting particles landing on a solid base, we start feeling uneasy and unsettled and want to start moving again. The prince of the air controls dark motion, which drives all within this dragon's kingdom's properties to prevent any from being still and a return to knowing God. This is known as a restless spirit or what I call a reverse resurrection, where we inherited a heritage from when Adam, the first man, ran and hid himself from God due to a dark and confused state of mind. Satan's darkness brought confusion from the fall of man, where he lost God's properties of being still and clothed

in His presence due to sin.

Satan's kingdom is a kingdom of dark motion. God asks this fallen angel, "Where do you come from, Satan?" in the book of Job. Satan responds, "From going to and fro and up and down in the earth." The devil is in chaos, as is its kingdom, whereas Jesus is known as the prince of peace and King of it. Motion causes us not to be in touch with who we are while in the commotion of trying to manage our own lives. For as children of the kingdom that we're from, when we are not at rest or restless, we belong to the devil. That is why the scriptures say, "We are to be anxious for nothing, but for all things with prayer and thanksgiving in your heart, let your requests and supplications be made known to God." This is why the scripture, "Be still and know that I am God," is so pivotal.

More scriptures reveal that Nicodemus asked Jesus this question, "How can a man be born again, can he enter his mother's womb a second time?"

Jesus said in response, "Amen, amen, I say to you, no one can enter the kingdom of God without being born of water and of Spirit. What is born of flesh is flesh, and what is born of Spirit is Spirit. Do not be amazed that I told you that you must be born from above. The wind blows where it will, and you can hear the sound that it makes, but you do not know where it comes from or where it goes, so it is with everyone who is born of the spirit."

Being born of water allows us to receive redemption and enter back into the resurrection cycle of love from before the fall of man. We are lifted out of this world by receiving the Holy Spirit, which joins us spiritually through the regenerative bloodline that doesn't die. We enter into the circle of fervent love, which burns as light to create the cycle of light and life of all creation. The properties of this world have no true solid foundation from which to build a true and

stable life, as everything is made out of particles that shift within the sands of time. No true stability in life proves that we belong to the devil. If not for the grace of God, which allows time for His children to be worked on or recalibrated, refashioned, and restructured into a “Holy” spiritual eternal life while here on earth, there would be no living growth.

Later in the scripture, Peter passes by a man in the street who is instantly healed. Peter’s shadow brought about healing because when the stability of eternity touches time, as a yielded vessel that was fully in this world and not of it, Jesus had compassion on the man through him. For, Peter was walking on the earth with the density of eternal life, which disrupted time enough to change its properties, restructure man out of compassion, and use this incident to glorify God. This matches the properties and is in keeping with God’s kingdom as “God delights in a just weight.” A just weight suggests balance to me, for love and truth to equate to a fervent loving light with a power of creation that affects our actions and spoken words to see within a maximum perception that creates revelation for life.

How do I know these things? Let me take the time out to boast about the Lord, who by His Holy Spirit is the revealer of mysteries. Now, back to Jesus talking to Nicodemus about eternal life. When we are born of the Holy Spirit, when He moves in, the minion spirits of this world move out. For, “What fellowship does light have with darkness?” We’ve experienced everything that minion counterfeiters use to distract our flesh from the Holy Spirit, guiding us into all truth by crumbs at a table that Satan has set to please our flesh. Now, read on for those who want to be diligent and escape this fallen angel’s clutches. “Faith is the substance of things hoped for, and the

evidence of things not seen,” for faith takes us out of this world to go to another place.

After being born again, we experience a new kingdom of spiritual life that is just as drastic as leaving our mother’s womb at physical birth. When we receive the Holy Spirit, we spiritually receive eternal life instantly, but the devil doesn’t want us to know this, so He distracts us with the things of this world within the members of our flesh to keep us from God’s Holy Spirit. Remember, “A double-minded man is unstable in all of his ways and let him not think that he shall receive anything from God.”

So, the first thing we need is the milk of the word, found in the four Gospels of Mathew, Mark, Luke, and John as a start. Then, as the Holy Spirit leads, as “He is the leader and guide into all truth,” we discover that “God’s word is sharper than any two-edged sword which goes down between the joint and the marrow.” We are now ready for more mature meals as religion is not an animal pen but a springboard into intimacy with God. I have found that “All of creation testifies of God” to be another pivotal scripture as this points to how all of creation speaks of the creator. I address this topic throughout the Calington Castle ten-book series.

Know this: It is necessary to practice only what you understand, and when you do right by God, He will honor Himself within you. I pray for Him to continue to take the I out of me until there is only Thee. The God who has a character of love who delights in a balanced weight by the truth of His living existence. Only by focusing on Him can we be built on a firm foundation; All else is shaky ground like sand.

I was caught up in the high hall of heaven and witnessed a vision while experiencing God's fervently intense love. I know it to be truly Him as I experienced Him once before when He translated

me back to Himself on the cross at Golgotha and hit me with a drop of His blood between my eyes, which put me in a blissful state. The Holy Spirit moved on me in a similar fashion during this incident, which happened once before through the power of His love. Now glory be to God, for this is what I saw.

There was a central core from which emanated a love so powerful that it generated a light that created life as I was alive in His presence. "Jesus Christ is the light and the life of all men," and by His pure and Holy existence, everything that does not adhere to the abuse from the circle of Satan's darkness cycles back to a central core of God's bonding love. Everything outside the circling cycle of love goes to the eternal damnation of abuse, where all of our energy becomes stolen in place of it being given to us in return for the wisdom of love.

Between these two circles, still on the cross in a moment of time, Jesus Christ holds this great divide open as "The Door." In this way, we may grow through Him from out of all that is dark and into the light of His kingdom of eternal life. We are joined to the circle of love through a resurrection that goes out in all directions, filling us (the church) with the essence of His being from within His eternal life as a bride who receives her bridegroom on earth as it is in heaven.

## Core Centrality

The central core of the vision I received is of the bridegroom bidding for the bride to come by growing out of Satan's dark circle of lies with a grace that changes the essence of our being into holiness. The core contains the regenerative blood between the Father and The Son in a bond of fervent love that sparks forth light into all creation from their truth by which everything exists.

This covenant bond is both replicated and is present in the Holy Eucharist as given by the hand of Christ as He is the High Priest. Jesus simultaneously enters into the Holy Host through all consecrated priests through Himself in an event called transubstantiation. This event transforms bread and wine into Christ's Body and Regenerative Living Blood. All men die through Adam, but through Jesus Christ, all men live.

Like a ship at sea, we ride the waves up, down, and around and all are orchestrated by God. Being in the right place at the right time in our lives, just for us, is the perfect storm. "Through many perilous trials, toils, and snares [in my life], I have already come, and there are no less days to sing God's praise than when we've first begun." We all die one day, but what a waste it is if we spend our life dead without really becoming alive. For if we find ourselves just going through the motions without breathing eternal breaths on earth as it is in heaven, then we never truly ever experienced being alive in a Christ who has changed our lives.

How does one know whether or not they have really been changed in their core existence? Actions speak louder than words when they're filled with love by those alive inside, and the eyes in the mirror never lie.

## Prophetic Spirit Connection

The prophets of old could see into the past and future by looking into the blood bond Covenant of eternal life with God. I know this because God brought me to a place in time where He directly commingled His own eternal blood with me. In a deep, powerful, wonderful, blissful vision, God has given me an understanding inside my thoughts. "To much has been given, much is required," which causes me to share.

Time is a projection from an eternity of reflection, "For to know God is to know eternal life." We see God from the essence of His single reference point, which connects with time, and we view from the breadth in dim distortions until there is light. For in knowing God, you can look into the pure light of His steadfast love and have any mystery revealed if He desires it. As a stable structure that's within stability, having an established pattern from which to conclude has no variables that shift.

"Everything that can be shaken will be shaken so that which will remain shall remain." Any point in time, in time itself, can be reflected from the point of an eternal centrality. God can bounce our point of reference off His light and return the light from resurrection love back into any point of time He wants, for any purpose, or veer from its darkness of abuse. Whether in the present, past, or future, every moment in time can be seen from the density of truth, which calibrates the positioning of all time after everything settles from being shaken and falls into place.

Prophets are transposed while existing in time, in that moment of time, the moment something is happening during that present moment in which God is sharing a part of His omnipotent omnipresence with them. God's omnipresence of essence is within

linear lines that are connected with every living thing while in rays of vector motion from a singular central point of existence from inside His density of truth.

When God invites someone to live in the divine, for a divine moment with Him, they can see through His lens of truth. It is now on record as something that will happen or has happened while in the moment of their existence. God, by bouncing a ray of His motion existence into someone's existence, brings one into the moment of His experience that shares an enabled pictorial communication with them. I see Him as projecting a reflection of Himself from His single focal point of truth into points of time that are unstable by using the stability of Himself. For He is both a part of time and apart from it simultaneously. He joins everything together at the ends of His particles that connect with the breadth while we pass through the wave of time. I believe that words of knowledge for healing and other purposes are given in the same way at all divine moments.

"Everything in creation testifies of God." Bats use sound waves to navigate their way around by bouncing them off solid objects. I see this as a very primitive translation of God using His focal point to navigate someone's vision throughout time. I believe that this is what happens when it comes to prophetic visions. All of time is a pinpoint reflection of the eternal and, therefore, falls into a sequence within the circle of love or abuse, depending on acts of free will if we do not pray. "Walk in the light as He is in the light that darkness does not overtake you."

Decisions towards light emanating from the fervent loving blood bond of God's regenerative (or eternal) life's properties in this resurrection cycle or death in damnation affects the world we live in. That is, if we do not pray to God and communicate resurrection love to expand its circle of influence on those trapped in abusive time and

further alter future events within time. For Jesus said, "I am the Alpha and Omega, the beginning and end," in reference to time, and as God cannot lie, "His mercy endures forever."

As you can see, there are many dimensions of God on many levels. I have grown through different stages of completion in each area of growth in my life. Every time I "taste and see that the Lord is good," I have partaken of a ripe revelatory fruit. God has unfolded much as I've sought to get to know Him, who is my defender, Savior from the devil's snare, and provider of every source of substance. He has my love as He has won my heart.

This is a sacred moment as God has met with me on the holy ground of His presence from within and roundabout me. Ahhh! There is no one as great as my God. I can only pray that you, too, will have many divine moments to further glorify God's Kingdom of our Lord Jesus Christ in the future. Amen.
