The Holy Spirit tries to sew strands of thread to make a fabric to compose reality, whereas minion spirits try to prevent thoughts from coming together through disruption. By ripping into the pattern of pure light that God had established within reality's fabric, minions try to distort or twist how He loves us and how to love others until His whole reality can no longer be perceived. The purpose is to blot out the truth of the strands of light that "We love because God first loved us," will no longer be perceived. In this way, only hate would exist without God's presence of pure love. When clarity is absent within a mind, strands of truth go missing, and a dark cavern for evil spirits to hide inside brings indecision.

For within the Mind of Christ's brilliance of light, there are spontaneous answers without a pause, and the evil that lurks in darkness cannot withstand this light.

Lags between thoughts have to do with the fallen state that mankind is in while living in the darkness of the breadth that passes through the heights, the depths, and the length of time. Without understanding eternal life, God is not sewn but remains unwed to us while passing Him by without conceptualizing our faith from lacking a real relationship with Him.

Memories of what God blesses us with as children spark forth love strands with an imprint on our minds to have a more complete

picture and are a gift of how to love others. Remembering that “To the pure all things are pure and to the impure all things are impure” allows us to be children in a child-like state until we develop to put off childishness as grown-ups. Or they shall become idolatrous stumbling blocks that distract us from a full relationship with God later in life. When our love is enhanced to understand Him as our bridegroom better, we are eager to meet Him without anything in our way as His bride.

A breathing space with clarity comes through the light and life of our bridegroom, Jesus Christ, as the Holy Spirit gradually entreats us to enter God’s kingdom of eternal life. Now we are finally in this world and no longer of it.

“I am the vine, and you are the branches, unless you abide in me, you can do nothing.” By abiding in and building a reality of faith, line upon line and precept upon precept, we weave a reality of trust through the fervency of God’s love with our mindful prayer conversations with Him a little at a time.

Reality strands become tight-knit together as our focus becomes greater than the spiritual darkness of this world. All of its physical accouterments that call us to try and block our peace from the light of life by obsessing on our surroundings in excess must be pressed through. God is our provider, and we must trust that the picture He will conceptualize in our minds is not a fabrication. Yet this is part of a grace that He will implement as we gain access to His kingdom according to His divine timing, which will always be on time.

We must learn to be comfortable within ourselves in every moment with God while remaining before Him. The cross is all-consuming as this is where all of the strands of the threads of His reality of love come together to protect us in the garment of our

relationship with Him. Common spiritual thoughts have bonds with what we are sewn to in marriage, which can be seen in the reflection of a mirror that never lies. What Makes a Picture in Our Minds Clear?

Reality consisted of only threads of light for a maximum perception of emotion and thought in balance. Being in harmony with God until the fall of man through Adam brought disruption. Everything slid out of balance here, where love and truth separated within our minds, making everything dark and confused. “What fellowship does darkness have with light?” and “Woe to those who call darkness light, for how great is that darkness.”

When the mind is dark, there is little or no vision for conceptualization to bring things to order, for “A people perish from a lack of vision,” while focus lacks threads of truth to offer a discerning light. All drift without an anchor on spiritual winds, and blindness sets in, leaving confusion from the absence of any sparks of light. One cannot see how to make a good choice when all is dark.

There are limitations during the confusion in the dark, which can only be overcome by introducing reality from The Christ, the light and life of all men. He is the one who brings a picture to mind that ignites all to life on an eternal scale in a darkened world. The truth of God brings vision to mind to enhance all clarity within our sight, as when having peace for perspective, we have a fair view that beholds every eye. Otherwise, we are ground down by a circle of thoughts, like clustering bees, that sting us in darkness rather than have us see the kingdom of God.

“Be anxious for nothing, but for all things with thanksgiving in your hearts let your prayers and supplications be made known, and the peace of God that surpasses all understanding will guard your hearts and minds.” Being in the waves that shake us apart while in the distortion of time, our minds remain unclear until we land in God’s kingdom on His firm foundation, stabilizing our vision within

So, we must speak to God with His Spirit behind our words after hearing them from every thought in our ears. Distracted from the fact that God has something better for us than receiving the gift of eternal life, we veer back into choosing darkness over light. Yes, by not trusting that God loves us more in His light over darkness and has something better than what we already have, we profess not to go to Him after receiving the first touch of His love, for we continue to proclaim knowing Him in word when in fact by our actions we do not. When being presumptuous as His bride in a fickle state, we pass Him by in our pride.

It takes a destroyer to tear down what God is building, and the end result is eternal death and not eternal life. “Satan is a roving lion, going to and fro in the earth, seeking whom he may devour.”

I found myself in a situation where I became spiritually attacked by a friend who came to me for spiritual help. It seems his life’s work was an obstacle for him as, on some level, it appeared to me that it was more important than his relationship with God. I prayed with him while standing my ground in the Holy Spirit, which locked my mind immovable while in the presence of His light.

He started to circle around me and then locked arms, taking me by surprise. He started to turn with me till I stopped my motion and focused even more intently on the light and love of my Lord. I noticed the continuation of him cycling around me in a circle till the Spirit of God revealed that the spinning sight he was in was a spirit looking for a place to find fault and accuse me to gain entrance into my soul. So I took him by his hands and started to sing praises to the Lord as I knew that God inhabits the praises of his people. He started to groan and grunt as he went through, going against the spirits driving him.

This was from experiencing the discomfort of the wind that was coming out from the cycle of death that he was in. First, he experienced friction from going against these minions, which drove the spiritual winds and kept him in motion without peace. Then, as he further came out of this pattern, I could tell that the friction turned to heat and a fiery trial as he progressed, and I continued to sing praise in the Spirit of the Lord. He began to froth at the mouth and spit till he next entered into the presence of the bond of my Lord as I continued in the stillness of His light while in eternal life.

He cried, "I can see these hideous creatures invading my mind." I then instructed, "Do not be afraid of them but let them strengthen your faith and instructed him to pray with me as I told him to say, 'You're not the God I serve, the Lord rebuke you, Satan, and get thee behind me. I renounce you and your kingdom of darkness.'" Afterward, he confessed his sins so that what hid in darkness would have no more space to remain within. "If we confess our sin, Christ is just and able to forgive us our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness." It is always essential to uncover the root cause on even deeper levels of where we took control of our lives in pride and allowed a minion (a demon from the abyss) to enter. They can start

growing within our minds, which are bombarded daily for a foothold to become a stronghold inside all souls.

He continued to run his thoughts of concern about his situation in his mind, which ground Him down to invite more darkness rather than the Lord's trust of light by faith. I next instructed him to flee this manifestation of evil by being still as a lost sheep till the Lord would bring him back into His fold where all of heaven would rejoice. After sharing this, I said, "Be still now and receive the Lord Jesus Christ's loving embrace." I then continued to praise my Lord until I discerned that the atmosphere in the room had turned to peace, and when I looked at my friend, he was smiling with a joyful grin.

After the battle, I instructed him to look in the mirror, which never lies for a lasting impression he would not soon forget. We next continued to praise God in a heavenly place, and this was written all over his face. Yes, "The Lord is our ever-present help in time of need," and "When the enemy comes in like a flood, God raises a standard."

"It will be important for you to stay in the word of God every day from now on," I said. Reading the bible is a perpetual exorcism, you see. For it is written in scripture that unless you first bind up the strongman, you cannot go into his house and steal his goods. We are this fallen angel's goods as Satan is the strongman that holds us prisoner within his kingdom of darkness until Jesus Christ redeems us back into His kingdom of eternal life. Yet once the attic, which is our minds, is cleaned, swept, and put in order, it will attack again unless there is something there to replace darkness and what lives within it. So be sure that once the demon has been driven out, it does not return as it shall invite other spirits to come back, and the latter state of that man will be several times worse than the first.

This is why it's important to consistently keep God's light in mind, as it prevents darkness from returning and becoming a host for these minions again. Always remember that we are being translated from out of Satan's kingdom of darkness and into the kingdom of Christ's light, which the devil continually tries to prevent us from entering any way that this fallen angel can.

I want you to understand that this incident, which God prepared me for after being trained to remain in His presence, is something I grew into over the course of nearly fifty years. This is something that God led me into and not something that I sought out on my own.

God prepares us before He leads and guides His servants into battle in His appropriate timing. If we try to set out and do things in our timing, Satan will trip us up by trying to get us to take on something we're not ready for. This is why we have to grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ by not trying to obtain a relationship with Him in an off-balanced manner for ourselves.

When it's our timing and not God's, there are consequences for our actions. Doing things in the way of "Our Strength," an abusive pride and temptation to power enter in. This is extremely spiritually dangerous, as not having the deeper humility of a love that would cause us to have a greater bond with God's embrace could again veer off on a tangent of sin until guided back to Him. "Greater is He that is in me than he that is in the world." Keep Christ in your focus at all times because if it does not look like Jesus in both Spirit and in truth from the true substance of the essence of His being, you are choosing what lives in darkness in place of the reality strands of eternal life.

Now, I do not know where God will lead me next, but I do know that if he truly guides me, the joy of the Lord will continue to be my

strength. I have passed through the door of Jesus Christ from the realm of darkness into eternal light and life.

Looking back, I can truly say that as long as I keep my hand in His to draw from His vine, which feeds me, stability will remain as His love restrains while remaining to grow at a pace of peace on His firm foundation.

“In the last days, there shall be a dividing between the goats and the sheep” as The Lord says, “In the last days, I shall pour out my Spirit upon all flesh where there will be those who wax hotter and those who will wax colder and fall away.”

We are what we eat spiritually. What we take into our souls, anything that leads away from the fullness of God's presence can affect us physically. The closer we walk with our Lord in the Spirit of our divine soul, the less room there is for what can affect our heart, mind, and physical body. If it does not look like Jesus, it isn't.

I put this question to you plainly: Are our glorified bodies a byproduct of being in the fullness of God's presence on earth as it is in heaven? “Enoch then walked with God and was no more for he was with God.” In the Old Testament, The Lord was so pleased with him that he took him. Could this have happened because he walked so closely with God that he entered directly into the full presence of His loving light to experience life eternal, exiting all darkness to step into His kingdom? Thus saith the Lord, “If you search for me with all of your heart, you will find me.”

I love my Lord and love to spend time with and talk about Him as I walk in the light of His loving presence before others. All is well with me, whether I live or die first, and then everything else becomes secondary.

I want to have genuine feelings toward others without being a pretentious pretender. It is not always easy to enter another's suffering unless focused on being a servant of God at all times.
